“But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. And not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offences unto justification. ...Therefore as by the offence of one (Adam) judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.” *(Romans 5:15-16, 18 KJV)*

If something is a free gift, you cannot pay for it – right? The free gift has already been paid for - by Jesus work upon the cross and His resurrection. We don't have to worry about doing the work of salvation – it's already been done – it's a FREE GIFT!

So, how do we receive the grace of God? How do we receive the free gift? Simple...Just ask!

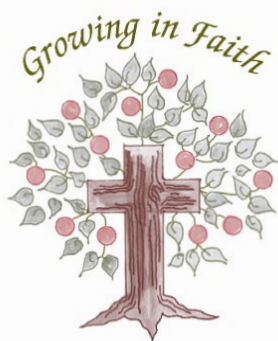
